Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project Inquiry and Advisory Committee (IAC) – New Arrangements for Bairnsdale Hearing

Due to the ongoing COVID-19 situation, the IAC is proposing a significant restructure of weeks 6-9 of the above Hearing which will affect all submitters in those weeks. The IAC apologises sincerely for this disruption, but the suggested changes are to facilitate a regional Hearing or regional input in the circumstances.

What you need to do

If you were scheduled to be heard in person in Bairnsdale between Wednesday 9 June 2021 and Friday 25 June 2021

These in-person Hearing days are being rescheduled due to COVID-19. Can you please contact the IAC **by midday (12 noon) Friday 4 June 2021** on Fingerboards.IAC@delwp.vic.gov.au with your preference to:

- a) be Heard <u>via Zoom</u> in the week commencing <u>Tuesday 15 June 2021.</u> If you have the capability to present via Zoom the IAC would appreciate you considering this option; <u>or</u>
- b) appear in-person in Bairnsdale in the week commencing <u>Tuesday 29 June 2021</u> or <u>Monday</u> 12 July 2021.

Note, if the later in person hearing days in (b) above cannot be held in person due to the COVID-19 situation and the directions of the Chief Health Officer, these hearing dates will then become Zoom video conference sessions.

If this occurs the IAC will explore opportunities for submitters to attend a venue <u>in Bairnsdale</u> to make their submission to the IAC via videoconference. <u>You should advise the IAC if you do not have any capacity to do video conferencing from home</u>.

Background

The IAC has been closely monitoring the developing COVID-19 situation. At the Hearing this morning the IAC discussed and sought parties' views on the proposed options for the Bairnsdale face to face



Hearing as outlined in correspondence dated 28 May 2021 (Tabled Document 438) and a fourth option¹.

Following the consideration of responses from parties, the IAC has determined the following course of action to provide certainty to parties going forward:

- The in-person Hearing currently scheduled for next week in Bairnsdale (Wednesday 9 June and Thursday 10 June 2021) and in Week 7 (15 June 17 June) and Week 8 (21 June 25 June 2021) will not be taking place.
- Submitters scheduled for those days will now be rescheduled into either:
 - a Zoom video conference Hearing session to be held in the Week beginning 15 June
 2021 (voluntary opt-in); or
 - a later in-person hearing day in Bairnsdale that will be held in the either the Week beginning 28 June 2021 (starting on Tuesday 29 June) and Week beginning 12 July 2021.

Represented Parties closing

Any represented parties, whose Counsel has particular times of unavailability in the weeks 12 July and 19 July 2021 are to inform Planning Panels Victoria by **midday (12 noon) Friday 4 June 2021** on Fingerboards.IAC@delwp.vic.gov.au.

Next Steps

Once the IAC has received responses from submitters who want to now be heard on video conferencing an updated Version 7 Hearing Timetable will be issued.
