I made submission No.224 regarding Kalbar Fingerboards Mineral Sands Mining Proposal/Application.

## My submission said:

Since I live , I have the following concerns about the transport of mine product to a railway siding on Fernbank - Lindenow South Road, close to me, and all associated operations which, for brevity, I will refer to as "Transport Operations". My concerns are:

- 1. What measures will be taken to prevent airborne dust arising from the Transport Operations adversely affecting local residents respiratory health, eye health, drinking water tanks, vegetable gardens and food animals, quality of life, and their properties in general?
- 2. What special measured will be taken to ensure that toxic and radioactive matter in the dust arising from the Transport Operations will never become airborne?
- 3. What Australian and international standards will the said airborne dust and toxicity prevention measures arising from Transport Operations be required to comply with?
- 4. What entity will monitor the said airborne dust and toxicity prevention measures, how often and how extensively, and how will the monitoring be reported and to whom? Will the results of the said monitoring be made public? Will the said entity be thoroughly independent from Kalbar?
- 5. At the peak of mine production, how many trucks and trains will be involved each day of the week in Transport Operations ?
- 6. What time restrictions (curfew(s)) and noise restrictions will be placed on such Transport Operations ?
- 7. What traffic management provisions are planned to prevent long delays for people using Fernbank Lindenow South Road ?
- 8. What maximum and average delays for motorists is/will be mandated in respect of Fernbank Lindenow South Road?

- a. Questions 1 and 2 above have not been adequately included or stated
- b. Questions 3 to 8 have not been included or addressed at all
