Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project Inquiry and Advisory Committee (IAC) – Notification of Third Directions Hearing

As foreshadowed in the Directions dated 19 February 2021, the Inquiry and Advisory Committee (IAC) will hold a Directions Hearing by videoconference using the Zoom videoconference platform at:

10.00am, Wednesday 31 March 2021

Purpose of the Directions Hearing

The Directions Hearing will cover, amongst other things:

- Reconfirmation of dates and consideration of outstanding material (if any)
- Timetable considerations
- Final hearing arrangements
- Additional site inspections

Proposal to sit five days a week in Weeks 1 and 2

The Proponent in its correspondence dated 26 February 2021 to the IAC (Tabled Document 151) indicated that it now needs 12 Hearing days to present its case (three weeks if the IAC sits four days a week as generally proposed).

The IAC is aware that some opposing legal counsel have availability issues between 17 - 31 May 2021 (Weeks 3 and 4 of the hearing) and would be limited in hearing the proponent's evidence and/or cross-examining expert witnesses in the third week of the hearing.

To address this limitation the IAC is proposing to sit for full weeks (five days/week) in Weeks 1 and 2 of the Hearing, and then four days a week for the remainder.

The Proponent has until midday (12.00pm) 19 April 2021 to provide its order of witnesses to the IAC and parties on the evidence distribution list (Direction 7). The IAC would be assisted if the Proponent, EPA, Mine Free Glenaladale and Council could discuss the order of experts in the first two (5-day) weeks to ensure that experts can be presented and questioned in the presence of Parties preferred counsel.



The Parties must report back on the outcome of these discussions at the Third Directions Hearing on Wednesday 31 March 2021.

The IAC notes the discussion between the parties will be on a without prejudice basis and will not prevent a Party from later cross examining other experts through alternative representation.

The second Hearing Timetable will be issued shortly.

When you join the videoconference can you please use your <u>first name and last name</u> so the IAC can easily identify you. If you are representing an organisation, include the organisation name after your name - for example, Nick Wimbush, Chair IAC.

All people who join the Directions Hearing will be placed in an attendee's room where you will be able to see the IAC members, but your camera will be defaulted to off and your microphone on mute. As directed by the IAC some parties will be moved to the presenter's room as required during the Third Directions Hearing.

Should attendees need to raise something with the IAC like a question as outlined in the guidance material, you can either click the chat function and send a message advising that you have a question or use the raise your hand function. The IAC will be alerted to this and will let you know when you can speak or will respond verbally at the appropriate time.

The Zoom Third Directions Hearing link will be published on the Engage Victoria website and will be accessible by the public who seek to observe the proceedings.

The IAC intends to record the Third Directions Hearing (audio only). Participants are prohibited from recording any part of the Third Directions Hearing in any form without permission from the IAC.
