## **Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project Inquiry and Advisory Committee - Hearing Timetable (v2)**

Please find attached the Inquiry and Advisory Committee's (IAC) Hearing Timetable (version 2) for the Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project.

### **Format of the Hearing**

The IAC is still planning for the Hearing to be a hybrid between videoconference and limited in-person submitter attendance in the region (depending on Covid restrictions).

As provided in the version 1 Timetable, participants with significant cases and/or calling evidence such as Kalbar Operations Pty Ltd (the Proponent), Mine Free Glenaladale, East Gippsland Shire Council, Government agencies and community groups will be heard via videoconference, and some individual submitters. 
