#### Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project Inquiry and Advisory Committee - Hearing Timetable (v3)

Please find attached the Inquiry and Advisory Committee's (IAC) Hearing Timetable (version 3) for the Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project.

The IAC has where possible incorporated into this Hearing Timetable the additional requests for time that were made by submitters with the supplementary submissions on centrifuges. Please note that in incorporating some of these additional requests for times, the Hearing will now be held in person on an additional day **Friday 25 June 2021** and on some days other submitters dates or times had to also change.

Please ensure you check the Hearing Timetable as soon as possible as you may have changed dates or times from version 2 to this current version.

There have also been some adjustments to the final week of the Hearing. The IAC has moved the closings for the main parties to the morning of Tuesday 29 June 2021 and have provided Kalbar (the Proponent) a dedicated day on Wednesday 30 June 2021 for its closing submissions. This change allows the IAC to direct all represented parties (the Proponent, East Gippsland Shire Council, Mine Free Glenaladale and the Environment Protection Authority) to provide their written closing submissions to the IAC and all parties on the evidence distribution list for uploading on the Engage Victoria website by **4.00pm on Monday 28 June 2021** if they wish to make such a closing submission.

The without prejudice drafting session that was scheduled to take place during the last day of the Hearing, will now be undertaken on the papers and further directions will be provided later. If there are any concerns with this approach submissions will be taken during the Hearing.

Details on the regional venue will be provided shortly. As a reminder the IAC is still planning for the in person Hearing to have limited in person submitter attendance. The IAC reserves the right to hold the entire Hearing by videoconference if the Covid situation deteriorates to the point where a part face to face Hearing is not possible.




