#### Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project Inquiry and Advisory Committee - Hearing Timetable (v7)

Please find attached the Inquiry and Advisory Committee's (IAC) Hearing Timetable (version 7) for the Fingerboards Mineral Sands Project.

The timetable has been restructured for weeks 6-9 due to the Covid-19 outbreak not allowing the Hearing to take place in person in the short term. All affected submitters have been rescheduled into either:


